All sheep must be removed from the premises on Saturday.

## Sale Rules and Guarantee

*It is the responsibility of the consignor to review sale rules and guarantees. Most notably, pairs will not be eligible to sell if lambs at the side of the ewe do not have scrapie tags and if you choose to test for brucellosis, negative test results will be noted on the sale order.*

1. Consignments are open to current members of the Mid American Dorper Breeders. All sheep must be ADSBS registered purebred or full blood Dorpers or White Dorpers, including baby lambs sold on the side of the ewe, or commercial ewes which must be at least 75% Dorper or White Dorper. Registration papers must be turned in upon arrival to the event (no pending registrations).
2. Mid American Dorper Breeders will be the financial agent for the sale, and settlements with consignors will be made within three weeks of the sale.
3. Ram Ratio: Each consignor may enter one ram. A consignor must enter one ewe for the second ram, and two ewes for an additional ram.
4. Animals, 10 months and older, going through the sale must be typed and pay an additional \$5.00 per head.
5. Once checked in, consignments may only be removed from the show/sale with permission of the Sale Manager or Sale Committee Chair.
6. All eligible consignments must go through the Sale.
7. All consignments must be slick-sheared within 30 days of the sale, except for commercial ewes. All consignments must be washed.
8. Minimum bids for the sale will be \$400 for single lots and \$400 per head on pen of two, and \$250 per head on pen of three commercial ewes.
9. Consignors must provide a valid breeding certificate on ewes sold as exposed.
10. Each lot, as well as any delivery sheep brought into the barns, must have a valid interstate health certificate.
11. All sheep, including baby lambs must have a valid USDA scrapie identification tag in the ear. Consignors should come

prepared with tags if hauling heavy bred ewes. In the event that lambs do not have scrapie tags, pairs will not be eligible to sell.

12. While not required by the State of Kansas, ALL RAMS, over 6 months of age, must be tested for brucellosis, as several states require negative test results for import.
13. White Dorper consignors must guarantee their entries to be negative for dermatosparaxis.
14. Consignments will be paint-branded, baby lambs will be paint-branded with the dam's lot number.
15. All consignments will be sifted for both soundness and quality. Only sound animals, and those of sufficient quality will be allowed to sell. The judge or committee will make the final decision.
16. Any animal sifted will not be allowed to sell and cannot be sold privately on the premises.
17. Entry fees are \$20 per head on singles, \$30 per pen of two, \$25 per pen of three commercial ewes. In addition, there will be up to a 10% sales commission on all sheep going through the auction, including "No Sales" and "Buy Backs."
18. Classes:
  - A) Yearling Rams (born September 1, 2023 - August 31, 2024) \* rams over 6 months must have a Brucellosis test
  - B) Yearling Ewes (born September 1, 2023 - August 31, 2024)
  - C) Early Fall Rams (born September 1, 2024 - October 31, 2024) \* rams over 6 months must have a Brucellosis test
  - D) Early Fall Ewes (born September 1, 2024 - October 31, 2024)
  - E) Late Fall Rams (born November 1, 2024 - December 31, 2024) \* rams over 6 months must have a Brucellosis test
  - F) Late Fall Ewes (born November 1, 2024 - December 31, 2024)
  - G) January Ewe Lambs (born January 1, 2025 - January 31, 2025)
  - H) Aged Rams (born August 31, 2023 and earlier) \* rams over 6 months must have a Brucellosis test
  - I) Aged Ewes (born August 31, 2023 and earlier)
  - J) Unaltered Rams \* rams over 6 months must have a Brucellosis test
  - K) Pen of 2 Ewes (born September 1, 2021 - December 31, 2024)
  - L) Commercial Pen of 3 Ewes: will be mouthed to verify age

**All aged rams** will need a certified semen test and a Brucellosis test. **All aged ewes**, up to 5 years old on day of event, have to be guaranteed to lamb within 1 year, by the consignor. **All aged ewes**, 5 years and 1 day or older, have to be certified bred or have a lamb at side on day of event.

19. Sale Guarantee is as follows: Except for those stated in the below guarantee, there are no warranties, either expressed or implied as to the merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose with respect to the sheep being sold in this sale. The warranties and guarantees set forth in the below guarantee are in lieu of all other warranties, either expressed or implied, and the remedies provided therein shall be the sole and exclusive remedy of the buyer, or any party claiming through the buyer, for any breach of warranty or guarantee therein provided, and all obligations or liabilities.
  - A) Every ram and ewe sold will be guaranteed as a breeder if properly handled. It shall be the responsibility of the buyer to return the non-breeders to the seller in acceptable breeding condition. The seller, after a fair trial and the animal is found to be a non-breeder, shall have the privilege of replacing the ram or ewe with one of equal value and/or quality to the satisfaction of the seller, or refunding the purchase price. This guarantee shall not apply the first year to any sheep that are shown subsequent to the sale date. All ewe lambs are exempt from the breeding guarantee the first year.
  - B) Notification of non-breeder rams must be made to the seller within six months following the sale. Notification of non-breeder ewes over six months of age on the date of sale must be made to the seller within one year of the date of the sale. Notification of non-breeder ewe lambs under six months of age on the date of sale must be made to the seller within 18 months of the date of sale.
  - C) This guarantee shall constitute a contract between the buyer and the seller only, and no other parties assume any liability, legal or otherwise, expressed, or implied.
  - D) Neither the Sale Managers nor sponsoring organizations can or will assume any responsibility as to the authenticity of the pedigrees, bloodlines, or information provided in the sale catalog, pen cards or otherwise, and the subsequent genetic performance of any sheep purchased. All such information must be accepted at face value. Any statements or information given sale day supersedes cataloged information. Any special guarantees or claims offered by individual consignors is strictly between the consignor and the buyer and will not be enforced by the Sale Managers or the sponsoring organization.
  - E) White Dorsers are guaranteed negative for dermatosparaxis. By consigning, the consignor agrees to stand behind any animal found to test positive and either replace the animal or refund the purchase price.
20. Consignors agree to be bound by these rules, and the terms and conditions of the sale. Violation will result in the right to the consignor being revoked for one year from the date of offense.
